* Zuhr time is calculated as 3 minutes after zawaal. It is not allowed to perform salah (with sajdah) for a 6 minute period before the start time for Zuhr. Asr time is based on Hanafi fiqh. In Shafee/Maliki fiqh, it starts about 1 hour - 1hour 15 min. earlier.

that among the sayings he related from his Lord
(glorified and exalted be He) is that He said:
"Allah has written down the good deeds and the bad ones.
Then He explained it [by saying that]*

*he who has intended a good deed and has not done it,
Allah writes it down with Himself as a full good deed,
but if he has intended it and has done it,
Allah writes it down with Himself as from ten good deeds
to seven hundred times, or many times over.*

*But if he has intended a bad deed and has not done it,
Allah writes it down with Himself as a full good deed,
but if he has intended it and has done it,
Allah writes it down as one bad deed."*
