# MCMC Safety & Security Guidelines

**Types of Security Concern** 

- Active Shooter: Covered in video
- Bomb Threat:
- Any bomb threat made against Masjid or graffiti should be immediately reported to Police. Depending on severity assumed either call 911 or Piscataway PD@732-562-1100.
- Unclaimed Bag
- Notify Management. If no one is in office, call Masjid
   @ 732-463-2004
- If still no one claims the bag call Piscataway PD @732-562-1100



# MCMC Safety & Security Guidelines

#### Fire:

- Call 911 & Follow Evacuation Plan
- Precautions
- First to Masjid, wait in car until few more individuals arrive.
- PRESET TO 911 Program and preset your phone to dial 911 from your home screen.
- Samsung Galaxy phones have safety assistance feature: Settings > Quick Settings > Safety Assistance > Send Help Messages. Once the feature is turned on, you can send an SOS alert by pressing your phone's lock button three times. For iPhone, add 911 to favorites.

## **FIRE Safety**




- On hearing the fire alarm or seeing visible smoke/fire
- Direct everyone to the nearest exit to evacuate. Evacuation should be done safely and calmly.
- Do not create panic.
- While evacuating, pay attention to & help: Children, Elders & Physically challenged individuals
- While evacuating, make sure no one is left behind. People may not have heard the fire alarm. Check rooms. Check bathrooms.





- Assemble at WEST End of Building




